May: The Month of Mary—As we celebrate this special month, enjoy these interesting facts about the Rosary, brought to you by the Spiritual Life Committee:

There are twenty mysteries of the rosary, divided into four categories: Joyful Mysteries, Luminous Mysteries, Sorrowful Mysteries, and Glorious Mysteries.

A mystery is a snapshot in the life of Jesus and Mary and provides an anchor to meditate on while you pray a decade of the rosary. Each mystery, each moment in their lives, holds incredible insights for our own lives today. Traditionally Catholics pray a specific set of mysteries on certain days of the week:

- GLORIOUS MYSTERIES—Sunday and Wednesday
- JOYFULL MYSTERIES—Monday and Saturday
- SORROWFUL MYSTERIES—Tuesday and Friday
- LUMINOUS MYSTERIES—Thursday
