There are twenty mysteries of the rosary, divided into four categories: <u>Joyful Mysteries</u>, <u>Luminous Mysteries</u>, <u>Sorrowful Mysteries</u>, and <u>Glorious Mysteries</u>.

A mystery is a snapshot in the life of Jesus and Mary and provides an anchor to meditate on while you pray a decade of the rosary.
