MCJF. The Month of Mary—As we celebrate this special month, enjoy these interesting facts about the history of the Rosary, brought to you by the Spiritual Life Committee:

- * Catholics were not the first to pray with beads. And, while the exact origin of prayer beads is unknown, men and women of many faiths and cultures (Hindus, Greeks, Buddhists, and more) have (and do) use beads to pray. In fact, the word *bead* in English is actually derived from an Old English word *bede* that means *prayer*.
- * The earliest form of the rosary developed when Pope Gregory the Great (590-604) popularized an earlier version of the Hail Mary prayer by asking it to be prayed on the fourth Sunday of Advent. Many began praying the Hail Mary in a repetitive fashion, using a string of beads to keep track of the prayers.
- * Third-century Christian hermits and monks in Egypt (known as Desert Fathers) used stones and later prayer ropes to keep track when praying the 150 Psalms.
